If you wish to vote part of your shares for and part of your shares against the relevant resolution in the event that a poll is called, please insert the number of shares of the Company in the relevant box.
- The form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer, attorney or other person authorised to sign the same.
- In the case of joint shareholders, the signature of any one shareholder will be sufficient but the names of all the joint shareholders should be stated. Where there are joint holders of any share of the Company, any one of such joint holders may vote at the 2020 AGM, either in person or by proxy, in respect of such share as if he/she were solely entitled thereto, but if more than one of such joint holders is present at the 2020 AGM, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders, and for this purpose, seniority shall be determined as that one of the said persons so present whose name stands first on the register in respect of such share shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.
- To be valid, this form of proxy must be completed, signed and deposited at the Company’s Hong Kong Branch Share Registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited (the “Hong Kong Branch Share Registrar”) at Shops 1712-1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong, together with a power of attorney or any other authority, if any, under which it is signed (or a certified copy thereof), no less than 48 hours (excluding any part of a day that is a public holiday) before the time appointed for holding the 2020 AGM or any adjournment thereof (as the case may be). Completion and return of the form of proxy shall not preclude Members from subsequently attending and voting in person at the 2020 AGM or any adjournment thereof (as the case may be), should you so wish, and in such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
- Any alteration made to this form of proxy must be initiated by the person who signs it.
- The Company reserves its right to treat any form of proxy which has been incorrectly completed in some manner as valid if such incorrectness is considered by the Company, at its absolute discretion, not material.
- A Member or his/her/its proxy should produce proof of identity when attending the 2020 AGM. If a corporate Member appoints its representative to attend the 2020 AGM, such representative should produce proof of identity and a copy of the resolution of the board of directors or other governing body of that Member appointing such representative to attend the 2020 AGM.
