This overseas regulatory announcement is made pursuant to Rule 13.09 and Rule 13.10B of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Listing Rules") and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined under the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

China Eastern Airlines Corporation Limited (the "Company") and all members of the board of directors confirm that the information contained in this announcement is true, accurate and complete, and no misrepresentations, misleading statements or material omissions are contained herein.

I. OPERATIONS

In March 2025, the Company's passenger transportation capacity (measured by available seat-kilometres) increased by 6.68% year-on-year; passenger traffic volume (measured by revenue passenger-kilometres) increased by 10.51% year-on-year; passenger load factor increased by 2.92 percentage points year-on-year to 84.16%. In March 2025, freight traffic volume (measured by revenue freight tonne-kilometres) increased by 11.10% year-on-year. In March 2025, for domestic market, the Company launched new routes such as Shanghai Pudong – Yan'an, Xiamen – Shijiazhuang, Changsha – Jinan, and resumed the operation of routes such as Taiyuan – Xiamen, Foshan – Kunming, Qingdao – Xi Ning; for international market, the Company launched new routes such as Chengdu Tianfu – Osaka, Yantai – Nagoya.

II. FLEET STRUCTURE

In March 2025, the Company introduced four A321NEO aircraft, with no aircraft retired. As of the end of March 2025, the Company operated a total of 816 aircraft. Details of the fleet structure were as follows:
