Announcement Trading Update Power Generation For September 2025

This announcement is made by CGN New Energy Holdings Co., Ltd. (the "Company") on a voluntary basis.

The board (the "Board") of directors (the "Directors") of the Company announces that, according to the preliminary statistics of the Company, the power generation of the Company and its subsidiaries (the "Group") on a consolidated basis amounted to 1,356.3GWh for the month of September 2025, representing a decrease of 14.9% compared with the corresponding period of 2024. In particular, power generation of PRC wind projects decreased by 37.4%, power generation of PRC solar projects increased by 47.7%, power generation of PRC gas-fired projects increased by 69.5%, power generation of PRC hydro projects increased by 8.1% and power generation of Korea projects increased by 2.1%. For the nine months ended 30 September 2025, the accumulated power generation of the Group amounted to 14,206.8GWh, representing a decrease of 3.0% compared with the corresponding period of 2024. In particular, power generation of PRC wind projects decreased by 2.2%, power generation of PRC solar projects increased by 26.1%, power generation of PRC gas-fired projects increased by 7.9%, power generation of PRC hydro projects decreased by 13.0% and power generation of Korea projects decreased by 11.4%.
