This compares to net loss of HK\$193.1 million for the six months ended 30 September 2024. The expected net loss is mainly due to the loss on disposal for The Connaught, a hotel held by the joint venture of approximately HK\$182.1 million and net revaluation loss of the properties held by the Group and joint ventures of approximately HK\$84.6 million together with the interest expenses of approximately HK\$23.8 million as a result of relative high interest rate and so the downturn in the property market.
