VOLUNTARY ANNOUNCEMENT

Signing of RMB1 Billion Sales Agreements for High-End AI Computing Power Equipment Accelerating the Commercialization of the Computing Power Business

Chinasoft International Limited (hereinafter referred to as “**Chinasoft**” or the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries collectively the “**Group**”) releases this announcement as a voluntary announcement to let the public know the latest information of the Company.

Following the Company’s formal entry into the computing power business, and to promote the exploration of the Group’s high-value Token operation business model and strategic transformation, the Company’s wholly-owned subsidiary, Beijing Chinasoft International Information Technology Co., Ltd., recently entered into sales agreements for high-end AI computing power equipment (the “**Agreements**”) with several independent third-party customers. Pursuant to the Agreements, the Group will supply high-end AI computing power equipment and supporting resources to the customer, with a total contract amount of approximately RMB1 billion. The relevant equipment will mainly be applied in the customer’s artificial intelligence research and development, high-performance computing and AI computing power infrastructure construction scenarios.

The implementation of the Agreements marks an important commercialization breakthrough for the Group's AI infrastructure business, and also indicates that the Group's high-end AI computing power segment has officially moved from the strategic planning stage into the stage of large-scale market implementation.

With the rapid development of the artificial intelligence industry, market demand for high-performance, highly stable high-end AI computing power equipment and supporting services continue to rise. The Company believes that the signing of the Agreements will effectively expand the customer base of the Group's high-end AI computing power business, enhance industry market awareness, and bring considerable sales revenue from high-end AI computing power equipment to the Group. At the same time, this cooperation will lay a solid market and business foundation for the subsequent development of high-end AI computing power equipment sales, computing power resource leasing, Token commercial operations, AI application integration and industry-wide intelligent solution services.

This high-end AI computing power equipment sales business can form efficient business synergies with the Group's existing AI product system, cloud service capabilities and vertical industry solutions, helping the Group connect computing power supply, model services and scenario-based industry applications, improve the integrated technology and commercial closed loop of "computing power-model-agent", and cultivate a new core business growth curve for the Group. The entering into of the Agreements is in line with the Group's overall strategic development plan and the overall interests of all Shareholders.

In the future, the Group will continue to advance the market-oriented operation of high-end AI computing power equipment procurement, sales and supporting services, actively expand upstream supply chain resources, optimize customer structure, broaden implementation scenarios across industries, and establish a sustainable and iterative commercial cycle for computing power procurement, delivery, sales and operational services.

The Company believes that, as the Group's high-end AI computing power supply and delivery system continues to mature and market orders continue to be implemented and expanded, the high-end AI computing power business will become one of the core pillars for the deep implementation of the Group's AI strategy and for driving long-term business growth.
